### 4. HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

**EYE CONTACT:** Irritation resulting from loss foreign bodies

**SKIN (CONTACT):** Inert material. Mild skin irritation may occur

**INGESTION (SWALLOWING):** Non toxic. Vomiting or constipation may occur if sufficient quantity is swallowed

**5. FIRST AID**

<b>EYE CONTACT:</b>	If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to by the Poison Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes
<b>SKIN (CONTACT):</b>	Wash affected area with soap and water.
<b>INHALATION (BREATHING):</b>	If inhaled, remove to fresh air. Rinse mouth with water and drink water to remove dust from throat. Blow nose to clear.
<b>INGESTION (SWALLOWING):</b>	Terminate exposure and seek medical advice. For advice, contact the Poison Information Centre on 13 11 26 (Australia Wide) or a doctor (at once). If swallowed, do not induce vomiting.

**6. PRECAUTIONS FOR USE**

---

<b>EXPOSURE LIMITS:</b>	Threshold Limit Value (TLV) for respirable dust (from dried clay) is 5mg/m <sup>3</sup>
<b>VENTILATION:</b>	Use a well ventilated area.
<b>PERSONAL PROTECTION:</b>	Approved dust masks should be worn when dealing with dry clay but are not necessary for wet clay handling. Eye protection is not require under normal circumstances. Wear normal work clothes.
<b>FLAMMABILITY:</b>	Non Flammable.

<b>STORAGE AND TRANSPORT:</b>	Protect containers against physical damage.
<b>SPILLS AND DISPOSAL:</b>	Avoid creating dust and preferably collect dust by vacuum cleaning or hose away with excess water. Wet clay on floor surface can be a slipping hazard and should be cleaned up immediately. Dispose of as a non toxic waste. Recycle where possible by the end user.
